Dear Parents,

Thank you to all those who completed our parent survey. Numerous responses indicated that seeing our COVID-19 Risk Assessment would be reassuring. In the coming weeks, prior to any re-opening our very latest Risk Assessment will be made available to view on our website.

The Risk Assessment attached to this message is for Phase 1 and 2 re-opening (Years 2-6). The attached Risk Assessment was submitted yesterday to MOD Schools for union scrutiny and further recommendations. Once we have received feedback, recommendations will be considered and appropriate action taken prior to any re-opening. Any requirement to action a significant change will be shared with you.

An additional Risk Assessment for Nursery, EYFS and Year 1 will be produced and released to parents prior to any planned re-opening. Both UK and German guidance for this age group is due to be released today. I will be considering this guidance after half-term with Miss Blair and our Nursery and Early Years teams. Any plans to rota face-to-face learning will be communicated to you.

As an on-going process, all of our Risk Assessments for COVID-19 will be updated weekly to reflect the latest guidance.

On the school website there is now a 're-opening procedures' webpage which includes the latest documents and 360° photographs of the classrooms and areas involved with Phase 1 re-opening plans.
