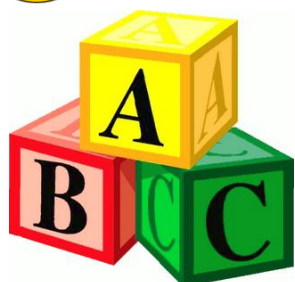

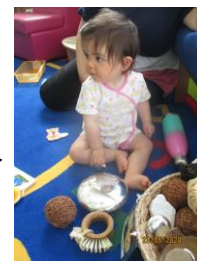
Attenborough Early Years
