Health updates

A polite reminder of COVID guidance issued to all MOD Schools:

- If any staff member or child develops **one or more** of the main coronavirus symptoms: a high temperature; a new, continuous cough; or the loss or change of their sense of taste or smell, they are required to remain at home and it is recommended they are tested by a healthcare provider (GP or nurse)
- If a child is tested because they are unwell with the symptoms identified above, they should stay off school until a negative result is received.
- Children may, and are likely to pick up common colds or feel unwell with a sore throat, stomach upset or a headache. In such cases, children may need to stay off school and parents/carers should contact the Medical Centre to seek advice prior to any decision being made about a return to school.
