1. Significant achievements Spring term 2021

- Site and infrastructure improvement- External improvements to Building 153 (FS Building); improvements to school entrance – safety barriers and main entrance restored; KS1 and KS2 nature garden further development, SEND hub and SEND room updated completed with external entrance and walls cleaned and painted; new CPD and training facility upgraded with new displays; teacher CPD reading library in operation; completion of FS regeneration (outdoor storage space and FS Art studio) and privacy screening. Ongoing infrastructure projects: School memorial garden and repair of school pathways.
- Successful Fire Risk Assessments completed for x3 buildings on site formal thank you to Mr Weston for his work as Fire Safety lead.
- Success of Remote learning and critical worker care during extended COVID closure (4th January 24th February 2021) excellent teacher use of Skype and Seesaw platforms have allowed pupils to maintain strong attainment performance- in particular Reading growth with Accelerated Reader (home access).
- Liaison projects and future partnership plans with AWS further support for community parents.
- Successful personalised support programmes for families and children with support of EPAS and Educational Social Worker Kim Harrison (SHAPE).
- Maintaining high quality Speech and Language and additional needs provision.
- Continued refinement of our Global Citizenship Curriculum through our 6 big ideas.
- Spring term attendance of 99.3% as a whole school despite continued presence of COVID 19.
- World Book Day 2021; Parent/Teacher Consultations and COVID colleague and pupil testing organisation.





Foundation Stage links with setting in Canada. New UK school link for KS2 lead and future writing development. *New partnership – Attenborough via our Twitter communication has been approached by a Maltese Education Academy chain with +30 primary schools who wish to develop their Mathematics provision by working with us through teacher visits between the two locations (Germany and Malta). Maths leader will be confirming details post COVID travel restrictions.
