

Daily Learning and Task Colleague Agreement 2022-23

Core learning skill (agreed instruction and practice)

Reading: Targeted readers (those below 100 SS) will be heard every day. All other pupils will be heard twice a week as a minimum. On each occasion, feedback will be written in home-school reading diaries with questioning reference from the Attenborough Reader proforma.

Handwriting: Follow the Penpals Handwriting sessions in all key stages and complete x1 unit each week. Unit sessions should provide both teaching instruction and practise opportunities.

SPAG/Phonics: FS and KS1 – Daily following SoundsWrite programme (session duration = 30 minutes) KS2-

SPAG or Phonics will be taught daily in Years 5/6 and on at least x3 occasions each week in Years 3/4

Mental Maths (Fluency): FS, KS1 and LKS2 – Daily (session duration up to 10 minutes)
