Project Updates

Main Playground – Work to commence (August 2023). Expected completion (September 2023). Planned outcome – new environmentally friendly playpark.





Renewal of Lower Court Playground – Work ongoing. Expected completion (End of June 2023). Planned outcome – Basketball & Mini-Football court with renewed court markings.

Whole School Sports Pitch – Central Playground – Work ongoing. Expected completion (October 2023). Planned outcome – New soft surface suitable for outdoor Physical Education lessons and recreational use during playtime/lunchtime. (See plan below)



Removal of previously 'unsafe' playparks – Work completed June 2023 – Planned outcome – return areas to natural spaces for general use.
